He, one of the eight participants representing Hong Kong, excelled in winning a Bronze Medal in the competition. The event, organised by the China Western Mathematical Invitation Committee, was held from September 26 to October 1 at Hohhot in Inner Mongolia. A total of 95 contestants participated in the competition, comprising 18 teams from provinces, cities or regions on the Mainland, and one team each from Hong Kong, Mongolia, Singapore, Indonesia and Tajikistan.
