- ☞ **Congratulations to our S6 students for achieving excellent HKDSE results this year**  
Our S6 students have attained outstanding results in the HKDSE 2014. Among them, Mak Chi Cheong has attained the best results with 5\*\* in seven subjects, Cheuk Tsun Leong has attained 5\*\* in six subjects while Chan Chung Fai, Chan Tai Hei, Fung Kin Yiu and Wong Hang Hin have attained 5\*\* in five subjects. The remarkable results build on the successes of previous years and are a tribute to the dedicated hard work and commitment of both students and teachers.
- ☞ **Our students had excellent performances in a series of renowned competitions:**
  - Our Chemistry Research Team, Matthew Chan Tai hei (6A) and Leo Fang Er Hai (6D), participated in the World Final of the Intel International Science and Engineering Fair (Intel ISEF) under the category of Chemistry. They were awarded the "London International Youth Science Forum - The Philip V. Streich Memorial Award", "Intel ISEF Best of Category Award (Chemistry)" and "First Award in the Category of Chemistry". They got two minor planets named after them by the "International Astronomical Union" (IAU) together with a scholarship of US \$8,000. *For more...*
  - Two teams of S.5 & S.6 students were nominated to participate in the I-SWEEEP, the International Sustainable World (Energy, Engineering, Environment) Project Olympiad. Bruce Chu Yat Ho (5D), Edmond Yip Tsz Fung (5D) and David Iu Shing Huk (5A) were awarded the Silver Medal in the category of Energy, while Leo Lo Kwun Yu (6A) was presented the Honourable Mention Award. *For more...*
  - The 5<sup>th</sup> Hong Kong Scout Group of King's College performed distinctively in the Hong Kong Carlton Trophy Competition 2014 held by the Scout Association of Hong Kong and won the overall Third Runner-up and a Champion in one of the major sections, Group Intelligent. *For more...*
  - Five of our S4 & S5 students won the Champion in the Hong Kong Chemistry Olympiad for Secondary School with their project titled, "Mechanism of Chinese Silver Staining Diagnosis and Its Application in detecting Phosphate ions and Chronic Renal Failure". *For more...*
  - The School English Debating Team has had a remarkably successful year in 2013-2014. With hard work and determined perseverance, the team progressed through four rounds at the Inter-government Secondary School English Debating Competition in which Yan Zhipeng (4A) and O Young Nicolas Qian (5A) won the Best Debater Award during the semi-final and preliminary rounds respectively. In the Grand Final, the team won the Champion and brought glory to our school.
  - Chan Cho Fung (5D) was awarded the Outstanding Student Leaders Award by the Hok Yau Club after passing through four phases of demanding assessment. This

year, nearly 300 S.4 to S.6 students competed for this honor. Cho Fung's outstanding leadership skills as well as his dedication to serve the community enabled him to outperform the others and won the top ten award. *For more...*

- In recognition of our efforts in promoting and practising the Sustainable Development concept, our school was presented the Sustainable Development Community Project Award in the Sustainable Development School Award Programme organized by the Sustainable Development Council on 5 July 2014 and we are one of the best three schools in this competition.
- A group of S4 & S5 students participated in the Moot Court Competition on Justice Education organized by The Society of Rehabilitation and Crime Prevention, Hong Kong. After a few rounds, the team was awarded the Third Runner-up and Cheng Koon Chung (5C) attained the Best Barrister Award.
