- ☞ The 29th China Adolescents Science and Technology Innovation Contest (第二十九屆全國青少年科技創新大賽) was successfully held in August 2014 in Beijing. Two groups of students from our school Research Team were selected to represent Hong Kong to compete in this contest. Congratulations were extended to CHEUNG Wai-wa (6A) who attained the First Prize (一等獎) in the Chemistry category, and CHU Yat Ho (6D), YIP Tsz-fung (6D) plus IU Shing-huk (6A) who won the First Prize (一等獎) in the Environmental Science category.
