Our students got excellent results in all arenas:

❖ **Hong Kong Youth Science & Technology Innovation Competition 2015 - 2016**

A team of S.4 students investigated the Visible light-induced Rust-catalyzed water splitting for hydrogen generation. They found that the glycerol water mixture in the presence of rust can be transformed into hydrogen gas effectively. With this remarkable invention, they won three prizes which were the Best Project Award, the Ricoh Sustainable Development Award 2016 and the First Place Grand Award in the category of "Energy and Environmental Science". In recognition of the team leader, Wei Ke Jun's outstanding performance, he was also awarded the Youth Scientist Award.

Another team of S.5 students investigated the chlorophyll cysteine co-catalyzed polymerization of PMMA and was awarded the Honourable Mentioned Award. [For more...](#)
