「一人一花計劃 2016-2017」
(中一至中二級學生適用)

敬啟者：

為學生提供全人教育，在德、智、體、群、美各方面都得到均衡的發展是本校向來的教育宗旨。特為全體中一、二學生推行「一人一花計劃 2016-2017」，此計劃的目標是為了：

1. 讓學生從容易栽種的翠蘆荊花苗開始，使花苗的生命於學生的手中茁壯成長，以培養他們對種植的興趣；
2. 讓學生給花苗澆水、施肥，給予時間和愛心，從而明白一分耕耘，一分收穫的道理；
3. 讓學生感受生命的奇妙和喜悅，懂得珍惜生命、愛護大自然的一花一草一木；
4. 從花苗開始，到開花結果，讓學生獲取成功感和提升自信心，當一個有責任感的人；
5. 讓學生懂得於忙碌而緊張的學習生活中，培養良好的嗜好；栽種花草既可陶冶情操，也可增添生活情趣。

有關計劃推行之詳情如下：

1. 分發資料單張、花苗和活動紀錄冊：
康文署將通過花苗供應商於二零一六年十一月上旬派送翠蘆荊花苗到學校。學校將於二零一六年十一月七日(星期一)，向所有中一學生分發花苗，中二學生則於二零一六年十一月十一日(星期五)分發花苗，讓學生把花苗帶回家栽種，並記錄花苗的生長過程和感受。同學必須從本校之網頁：<http://www.kings.edu.hk> → **Important Notices** → 一人一花計劃 2016-2017 紀錄冊 (中一、二級適用)，自行下載有關紀錄冊，以便於明年的二月份繳交。
2. 學生必須根據學校所訂的時間和地點，帶備一個小塑料袋前往領取花苗(免費)，以便攜帶回家。學生栽種花苗時，需自行準備花盆、花盆底碟、混合泥和肥料等物品。為了環保，不一定要買新的花盆，家中有任何適合種花的器皿都可善用。
3. 學生在栽種翠蘆荊的過程中，必須在活動紀錄冊上記錄在家種植的過程、為花苗的成長過程拍照和抒發感受等。
倘若在栽種期間，因栽種不得其法或其他因素而導致花苗枯萎，請同學拍照為證，記錄有關枯萎的日期、原因和感受等，並盡快於兩天內交回學校處理。
4. 在家栽種期間，家長可跟貴子弟一起合作照顧花苗，既可促進和諧的親子關係，也可共同分享栽種的樂趣。
5. 所有中一、二學生需根據該計劃的指引完成活動紀錄冊，並於明年的2月上旬(日期容後通知)，把栽種的翠蘆荊和活動紀錄冊交回學校，以便進行比賽。
(冠、亞、季軍各一名，優異獎7名。)

我們深信有各家長的支持，對此計劃和學生必起積極的作用；故懇請各家長配合，並督促貴子弟積極地實踐此計劃，以加強學生的責任感和愛心。請於十一月四日或之前透過 e-ClassApp 或 eClass 內聯網系統簽署回條。

“One Person, One Flower Scheme 2016-2017” (Attn: S.1 to S.2 Students)


Our school is devoted to delivering whole person education, fostering moral, intellectual, physical, social and aesthetic development of our students. The captioned scheme is one of the programmes designated for our Secondary 1 and Secondary 2 students in this regard:-

Implementation details of the subject scheme are summarised as follows:-

1. Distribution of pamphlet, seedlings and activity logbook:
Leisure and Cultural Services Department of Hong Kong has partnered local suppliers/distributors to jointly supply *Ruellia coerulea* seedlings to our school in the first fortnight of November 2016. The school has scheduled to dispense the plants to all of our Secondary 1 students on 7 November 2016 (Monday) and Secondary 2 students on 11 November 2016 (Friday) respectively. All receiving students shall raise the seedlings at home and track the plant growth and record their personal reflections and thoughts during the scheme period in the activity logbook. **The activity logbook is available for download at the website of our school: <http://www.kings.edu.hk> → Important Notices → “One Person, One Flower Scheme 2016-2017 (Applicable to Form 1 and 2 students)”** The completed activity logbook shall be submitted to school in February 2017.
2. All Secondary 1 and Secondary 2 students shall bring a small plastic bag to school on the abovementioned dates to collect seedlings gratis. All receiving students should prepare a flowerpot set, loamy soil and fertiliser for nuancing the plant. Any containers at home suitable for planting and cultivation may be used as a flowerpot.
3. All participating students shall record their cultivation processes, track the plant growth and express their reflections and thoughts in the aforesaid activity logbook. Photographs are also required for the plant growth tracking purpose. If the plant withers in the scheme period, the student should record the date and reason as well as his personal feelings arising therein in the activity logbook. The appearance of the withered plant shall be recorded by photographs. The activity logbook and the photographs shall be submitted to school as soon as practicable within two days after the incident.
4. Parents are encouraged to jointly take care of the seedlings with our students for enhancement of parent-child relationship.
5. All Secondary 1 and Secondary 2 students should complete the activity logbook in accordance with the pamphlet's guidance and all other instructions from our school. The completed activity logbook shall be submitted to the school together with the *Ruellia coerulea* in the first fortnight of February 2017 (with exact date to be announced later) for competition assessment. A champion, a first runner-up, a second runner-up and 7 outstanding plants will be determined based on the assessment result.

Trusting that the scheme is of tremendous value to our school's quality education and our students' moral development, we appeal to your benevolent support as well as your effective supervision on your children's commitment and performance in the scheme.
